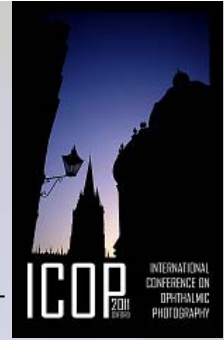

Dear friends,

Update 3 August 2010

It is with the greatest of pleasure that I provide some additional information regarding planning for ICOP2011, for your eternal joy and edification.

First off, the dates are now fixed as **Thursday 22nd to Saturday 24th September 2011** inclusive. We have drafted out a block schedule for the meeting which includes 14.5 hrs of scientific content in 6 sessions across the 3 day period.

The meeting is to be held in the historic University City of Oxford. Oxford is 45 miles (74 km) to the west of London and is served by multiple hourly buses and coaches direct from London centre and London's main airports Heathrow and Gatwick. Excellent train services and major roads also connect Oxford to London, Birmingham (International Airport - 67miles), Stratford-upon-Avon (45 miles) and the local beautiful Cotswolds region.

The location for the actual meeting is a wonderful building, never normally open to the public and certainly not on the normal 'tourist map'. All graduates and students from Oxford will know it however (with dread...) as it is the University's **Examination Schools** (image right). Situated in the heart of the main High Street, it is seconds/minutes away from most of the major tourist attractions including the Radcliffe Camera, Bodleian Library and many of the Oxford Colleges.



As Oxford is an historic (1000 year-old) city, large hotels are thankfully not to be found within the central region. As such, we have arranged for a significant number of very comfortable rooms to be pre-booked at the **Holiday Inn, Oxford**. The new 4* hotel is about 3 miles (approx 5 km) north / west of the city, off the main ring-road, nestled in-between some of the major road arterial routes in, out and around Oxford. The hotel has over 150 rooms, restaurant, bar (of course), indoor pool, fitness and spa facilities and free car parking! All rooms are of course en-suite plus are fitted with refrigerators. Complimentary daily coach transfer between the hotel and meeting venue (and sometimes back again!) will be provided.

Things are moving steadily forwards.....(but nothing is yet sealed or signed of course!)
